After fifteen years as an orchestral soloist at the Opéra national de Paris, Éric Aubier – International Visiting Professor of Trumpet at the Royal Academy of Music – divides his time between concert activities and teaching. Committed to the development of repertoire for his instrument, he has worked with many leading present-day composers, including Betsy Jolas, Thierry Escaich and Karol Beffa.
