Notes

1. The applications data is based on that provided by UCAS and relates to UK domiciled applicants only. The Academy does not collect, or record, the ethnicity of other individual student applicants.

2. The enrolled students data provided is also that of UK domiciled students only, to allow for direct comparison with the application data provided.

3. We are unable to provide specific student data as disclosure is exempt under section 40 of Freedom of Information Act 2000. Section 40 provides exemption for information, where disclosure would contravene any of the data protection principles contained in the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2018. Where disclosure of specific data has not been possible we have employed the Higher Education Statistics Agency (HESA) rounding strategy which involves rounding data to the nearest multiple of 5, with data of 1-4 being listed as <5. This means that column/row totals may not necessarily equate to the exact sum of the data theyrelate to.
