# Ways things go

for solo clarinet in Bb

*Ways things go* is one of a collection of 200 solo pieces commissioned to celebrate the bicentenary of the Royal Academy of Music in 2022. The premiere performance was given by James Gilbert at the Duke's Hall, Royal Academy of Music, on 9th November 2021.

## About the work:

This piece was loosely inspired by Fischli and Weiss's art film *The way things go*, which presents a causal 'chain reaction' (something like a Rube Goldberg machine) featuring everyday objects and industrial materials. The starting point for the work was an exploration of similar chain reactions which connect apparently unrelated musical events into a continuous line. As the piece unfolds, short motivic starting points are progressively explored and transformed, sometimes appearing in radically different, distorted forms. Much of the material was developed in a free and improvisatory way, working with approximate musical shapes and contours which could be revisited in different modal/harmonic contexts throughout the piece.
